



## Kindle & Kindle App:

### Downloading and Reading e-books



Before you get started, make sure you have the following: a valid Farmington library card, an Amazon account and a Wi-Fi connection. You should also sign in to your Amazon account before you begin with Overdrive.

1. From the **farmingtonlibraries.org** home page, go to “Books & Media” on the main navigation menu (blue bar) and select “Overdrive E-Books” from the dropdown menu.
2. Sign in to Overdrive by selecting Farmington Libraries from the dropdown menu and then entering your Farmington Library card number. If you have a library card from a different town you will need to select that library from the dropdown menu and then enter your card number.
3. Select a book to checkout by searching or browsing for available titles. Click on the book or book title to open the details page.
4. On the right side of the details page you will see a small box that says “Available Formats”, make sure Kindle Book is listed. After you have confirmed it is available in the proper format click “Borrow”.
5. You are then brought to your “Bookshelf” where you can download your new title by clicking the drop-down menu and selecting **Kindle Book**, then clicking **Confirm & Download**.  
*Note: You will now be taken to Amazon's website so that you can complete the checkout and send the title to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app.*
6. From the book’s Amazon page, select a device (i.e. John’s Kindle) from the 'Deliver to' drop-down box, then click **Get library book**. The book is sent to your device. You'll find it on your Kindle home screen.  
*Note: If you do not have an available Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer the title via USB. Amazon provides instructions on how to do this.*
7. Once a title is on your device or reading app, open it from your Kindle home screen to begin reading.
